

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capability, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the tine eye. Various manufacturers would differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
